








#### **Register for the 2016 Annual Meeting!**

## **Travel Stipend Program**

New this year, NAPCRG has initiated the trainee stipend program which offers ten \$1,000 stipends for attendance at the 2016 Annual Meeting in Colorado



Springs, Colorado, November 12-16. The stipend can be used for expenses required for meeting attendance including transportation, hotel expenses and meals.

# **American Cancer Society Cancer Control Career Development Awards for Primary Care Physicians**

The American Cancer Society, the largest private, not-for-profit funding source for cancer research and training, has announced the 2016 Cancer Control Career Development Award for Primary Care Physicians (CCCDA). The purpose of this award is to encourage and assist primary care physicians who will pursue academic careers with an emphasis on cancer control. Through the CCCDA, the Society seeks to provide opportunities for promising individuals to acquire and enhance knowledge and skills in primary care practice, education, and research activities related to cancer control. Awards are for three years and for up to \$100,000 per year. A maximum of \$10,000 per year for the mentor(s) may be included in the budget.
