What should my submission include?

Poster Presentations:

- Title
 - Abstract include the following sections:
 - o Context
 - o Objective
 - o Study Design and Analysis
 - o Setting or Dataset
 - o Population Studied
 - o Intervention/Instrument
 - o Outcome Measures
 - o Results
 - o Conclusions
- Learning Objectives
- Research Category
- Study Design

What should my title include?

125 characters including spaces. Do **NOT** use all capitals.

How many characters should my abstract be?

The abstract should be no longer than 2,500 characters in a single paragraph with the following subheadings: Context, Objective, Study Design and Analysis, Setting or Dataset, Population Studied, Intervention/Instrument, Outcome Measures, Results, Conclusions. Include ONLY the abstract. Do not include title or author(s).

What research categories are accepted?

We accept a large range of research categories. You can select the one that best fits your submission on a drop down. You can provide up to three categories for your submission.

Is the research category important?

Yes, it is. The research category helps us to schedule break-out sessions.

What is a learning objective?

What you want learners to take away and implement after the session in active, measurable terms (e.g. - define, interpret, explain, apply).

How long should the learning objective be?

Learning objectives should be no longer than one sentence.

How many learning objectives do I need to provide?

A minimum of two learning objectives are required for a submission.

Can I save and return to my submission if I do not finish it?

Yes, you can save and return to your submission. It is important to make sure to fully complete your submission by the posted deadline.
